All classes in this schedule are to be regarded as exhibits.

Class 1. Just Give Me a Space (and let me do what I want)

Space allowed: Width 1m, depth 1 m, height optional.

To be staged on a grey composite floor. Competitors to provide their own base. Up to two people may stage this exhibit.

Class 2. Sizzling Hot

Space allowed: Width 76 cm, depth 76 cm, height optional.

To be staged on tabling 76 cm from the floor, draped with black fabric, against an off-white wall.

Class 3. Coastal Treasures

Space allowed: Width 76 cm, depth 76 cm, height optional.

To be staged on tabling 76 cm from the floor, draped with black fabric. Open tabling but to be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 4. From the Shed (NOVICE CLASS)

Space allowed: Width 76 cm, depth 76 cm, height optional.

To be staged on tabling 76 cm from the floor, draped with black fabric, against a black draped wall.

A novice in this class is someone who has not previously won a First Prize at a NAFAS Area or National Show.

Class 5. Fruits of the Earth (IMPOSED CLASS)

(See Rules below)

Space allowed: Width 76 cm, depth 76 cm, height optional.
To be staged on tabling 76 cm from the floor, draped with black fabric.
Open tabling but to be viewed and judged from the front.

The entry fee for this class is £30 where all components will be provided and will become the property of the competitor.

Some of each of the provided components must be used and nothing extra may be added.

A basic tool box only is permitted and no extra decorative items are allowed.

This class is kindly sponsored by Mills N Blooms, Brighton.

Class 6. A Glimpse of Beauty (Petite - Small Scale Design)

Space allowed: Width 25 cm, depth 25 cm, height 37 cm
To be staged on black gloss staging, 1m from the floor against black draped background.

Class 7. On the Grid (SEMI-IMPOSED)

Space allowed: Width 21 cm, depth 77 cm
To be staged on a metal grid, width 17 cm, depth 63 cm which will be hung on hooks against a black background. To be staged by the Show Committee.
An extra non-refundable fee of £2 is payable for this class. Full details of the staging, including a sketch of the metal grid and hook, will be sent out on acceptance of entry.

Competition Regulations & Information

- Only members of clubs and societies affiliated to the Sussex Area of NAFAS may compete.
- All classes to be viewed and judged from the front.
- All exhibits will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual Third Edition 2015.
- All exhibits must be staged in the space allocated and must be the Competitor's own work and not previously exhibited.
- All measurements in the schedule are approximate.
- All exhibits and personal property are at the risk of the Competitor. Neither the Area nor the owners of the venue will be liable for any loss or damage.
- Entries for all classes must be made on the official entry form and returned to the Competitions Secretary with a stamped addressed envelope by Friday 27 July 2018. A returnable deposit of £5 payable to the Sussex Area of NAFAS must be sent for each entry.
- All exhibits must be assembled at the venue, with the exception of Class 7, where the mechanics for the exhibit may be brought assembled and ready to be hung by the Show Committee.
- Pre-done work consisting of any techniques requiring a considerable amount of time to complete are acceptable in any class.
- **Staging**
Friday 7 September from 11 am to 4.30 pm. All competitors must vacate the building by 4.45 pm
Staging for Class 5 will take place from 12.30 to 3 pm
- **Judging**
Friday 7 September, 5 pm to 9.30 pm
- **Dismantling** is permitted on Saturday, 8th September, 6 pm to 8 pm
- **AWARDS**
Each class will be awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd, Very highly commended, Highly commended and Commended.
Prizes – 1st - £30, 2nd - £20, 3rd - £10
